Contains, heraldry and genealogical particulars on every memorial in the above churches with extracts from parochial registers, annotated with notes from wills etc.

Parochial History of the County of Cornwall (4 vols)

Lake's Parochial History of Cornwall by Joseph Polsue is a classic history of the Cornish Parishes. Parish based rather than a county history. There are local customs and details of the Churches, even strange

pre-history houses near St Just that you can still visit. 'Important' parishes get many pages but the more humble parishes are not neglected.

Cornwall by Arthur Leslie Salmon 1903

A topographical dictionary of the places of Cornwall & the Isles of Scilly – starting with Advent and finishing with Zennor.

Post Office Directory of Cornwall 1856

An excellent and comprehensive directory. Each town, village, and hamlet is described in detail with information about churches, schools, hospitals and other institutions that our ancestors may have used in their daily lives. Each place has lists of gentry and more.

Pigot's Directory of Cornwall – 1844

This is one of the earliest directories and covers the whole county, with descriptions of all the main towns and villages, churches, schools, etc'. plus, a listing of people and their trades in each place. Everything from Dr's to candlestick makers, dressmakers working from home to chimney sweeps and much more - all of interest to historians and genealogists.

Robson's Directory of Cornwall 1839

A detailed directory of the major towns and villages in Cornwall, providing names, addresses, and occupations of the inhabitants.
