We also offer group visits, talks and lectures, as well as being open to the public for visits to the museum and the old military police cells. We have two conference rooms and kitchen facilities and also hold events and exhibitions – our latest is 'The History of the Barracks. The museum holds the DCLI collection, the national collection of the Light Infantry, and probably the finest collection of medals and weaponry in the South West.



After the 18th of March we will be open 7 days a week, and for only £6 (adult standard) visitors will receive an annual museum pass.
