The Federation of Old Cornwall Societies invites all society members to this year's Summer Festival hosted by Callington Old Cornwall Society, as part of their 90th Anniversary Celebrations on Saturday, 30th June, 2018.

The venue will be Callington Town Hall, New Road, Callington, PL17 7BD. The doors will be opened at 10.00 a.m. and the day will commence with the usual Parade of Society Banners at 11:00am.

To conform to Health and safety and Fire Regulations numbers attending will be restricted to 200 maximum.

The Heritage Centre will be opened specially for our event during the afternoon and hosted by local volunteers.

We are offering a guided tour of the small stone Medieval Hall and Medieval Chapel at Trecarrell Manor. Built by Sir Henry Trecarrell in the parish of Lezant where the Trecarrell family had their seat. Now the home and working farm of Mr. Neil Burden.

A visit to the summit of Kit Hill is also offered with panoramic views of Bodmin Moor, North Cornwall, Dartmoor and Plymouth to the South, with the final tour being to the only two surviving miners cottages in Cornwall in their original state.

All tours are guided and therefore restricted in number, it is ESSENTIAL that members wishing to visit them return the booking form a.s.a.p. to avoid disappointment.

Walking tours within the town combining the Heritage Centre with some Town History and the Mural Trail with St. Mary's Church are also offered.

It is intended to finish by 4:30pm.

There is a FREE car park on the edge of town as indicated on the map enclosed. A pay car park is situated next to the Town Hall. Maximum parking charge is £5.00.

The cost of the ticket is £6-00 which will include drinks and a saffron bun.

A beef or vegetable pasty can be ordered at an extra cost of £3-00. Please complete the booking form making payment payable to 'Callington Old Cornwall Society'.
